- 1. Security System Outside and Inside keeping our pool safe from thieves.
- 2. New Flooring in Clubrooms paint chip flooring perfect for wet feet.
- 3. New Cupboards in the Clubrooms our trophies are looking great now.
- 4. New 14m Pool Banner to offer Club promo and privacy on Eastern Fenceline.
- 5. Concreting and Diving Blocks for both ends of the pool Carnivals are amazing.
- 6. Storage Area Upgraded old toilets removed and shelving added, more space.

With your continued support we hope to keep improving the swimming experience for all. *Our future plans...*

- 1. Roller Door added to Storage Room approx \$1000 to make access easy for pool equipment.
- 2. Perspex Added to all Screen Doors approx \$600 to fix dust issues.
- 3. Multimedia Setup for Clubrooms approx \$1500 Make the clubrooms worthy of being a meeting room with a Smart TV and Sound system, also ideal for poor weather club training.
- **4.** Blinds for Clubroom Windows approx \$4000 horizontal blinds to cut down the glare in the clubrooms for the multimedia setup.
- 5. Canteen Upgrade approx \$3000 new fridge and reverse cycle air conditioning installed.
- 6. New Training and Racing Lane Ropes approx \$6700 Lane ropes are getting brittle and need replacing, used for carnivals including Friday nights, Open Carnival and School Carnivals and for training sessions.
- 7. Dolphin Timing System approx \$15,000 club would like to have the timing system for Friday nights, open carnivals, use at training, SAPSASA trials.
- 8. New Perspex added to Swimming Clock approx \$200 current perspex has become foggy due to weathering, hard to read.
- 9. New Recycle Bins Approx \$1000 possibly in the shape of a penguin. Old bins need replacing.
- **10. New LED Entrance Lighting on a Timer with a Dimmer approx \$500** lights that last and will brighten when people are detected nearby as a deterant for intruders.
- 11. Water Feature for the Baby Pool approx \$2000 looking at a mushroom to add more fun.
