- 1. Concreting and Diving Blocks for both ends of the pool Carnivals are amazing.
- 2. Storage Area Upgraded old toilets removed and shelving added, more space.
- 3. New Training Ropes for Swim Club training nights
- 4. New seating removing old wooden stools with moulded plastic seating
- 5. New Swim Club BBQ larger BBQ to serve more super hot snags
- 6. Roller Door on Storage Shed to make the movement of equipment easier
- 7. Blinds installed in the Clubrooms for better privacy of equipment in the clubrooms

With your continued support we hope to keep improving the swimming experience for all. *Our future plans...*

- 1. Canteen Upgrade approx \$3000 new fridge and reverse cycle air conditioning installed.
- 2. New Pace and Digital Clock need a new pace clock and a new digital clock at the southern end of the pool out of the shine of the sun for swimmers to view
- 3. Perspex Added to all Screen Doors approx \$600 to fix dust issues.
- **4. Multimedia Setup for Clubrooms approx \$1500** Make the clubrooms worthy of being a meeting room with a Smart TV and Sound system, also ideal for poor weather club training.
- 5. Racing Lane Ropes approx \$5500 Lane ropes are getting brittle and need replacing, used for carnivals including Friday nights, Open Carnival and School Carnivals
- 6. Dolphin Timing System approx \$15,000 club would like to have the timing system for Friday nights, open carnivals, use at training, SAPSASA trials.
- 7. New Recycle Bins Approx \$1000 Old bins need replacing.
- 8. New LED Entrance Lighting on a Timer with a Dimmer approx \$500 lights that last and will brighten when people are detected nearby as a deterant for intruders.
